Newly cleared and open, The Flats offer a laid-back atmosphere just beyond Basecamp. A great option for those looking for extra space and close parking access.

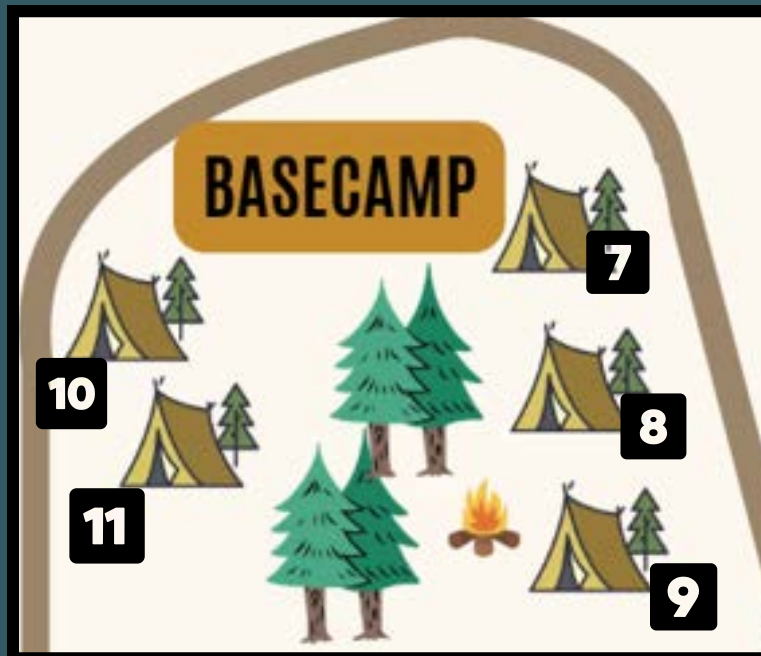
LAST PITCH
